Prayer Focus: Direction

Prayer: "Lord, on issues facing the Church of God, our fellowship of congregations, as the General Council and the General Assembly meet in a few weeks, give direction. We ask for wisdom. We ask for guidance. We pray, in the decision process, not for a spirit of division, but of unity and conciliation. May we hear from heaven – from You. Speak to us and show us the way. May new direction unwrap vision with unity and fresh resolve."

Daily Prayer Points:

- MONDAY Pray that the Holy Spirit will speak to the Church (Acts 13:2).
- TUESDAY Pray for divine surprises (Acts 2:1-4; Ez. 37:7).
- WEDNESDAY Ask God to give his pastors and leaders wisdom, to guide and direct them (Prov. 3:4-5).
- THURSDAY Pray for unity God blesses unity (Psa. 133).
- FRIDAY Demonstrate unity. Connect with 2-3 others sometime today, and pray – together – for God's direction. For God's blessing and favor.

WINDOW ON THE WORLD

If the whole world were a village of 100, there would be 42 radios, 24 televisions, 14 telephones, and 7 computers, but they would not be equally distributed. Only 7 people in the village would own an automobile. Five souls alone would possess 32% of the entire village's wealth, all from North America. You would be one of them. The poorest one-third, most in the 10/40 window, would receive only 3% of the total village income.

HARVEST NOTES

World population is growing at the rate of 1.6% annually, Islam at 2.7% annually, Hinduism at 2.3% and Buddhism at 1.7%. Christianity is growing at the rate of 2.6% annually. Evangelicals at 5.7% and Pentecostals and Charismatics at 10%.

PRAYER PRINCIPLE

ACTION IDEA

Block out an hour or so for prayer - and get a Bible and notepad. Drive to a crossroads, an intersection, a fork in some road. Park. Meditate. Think about the choices you have made in your life. Make a decision. to never change directions without seeking his guidance. And remember. He even redeems bad choices. On his map, all roads lead back to joy in Jesus.

Consider This:

24% of the formerly churched say they are "spiritual, not religious." 42% say they are "Christian, but not particularly devout." Less than 1 in 5 identify as "a devout Christian with a strong belief in God." 10% are on the edge of rejecting Christianity. 6% are considering abandoning belief in God at all.
