The prophet Hosea faces a challenge unique among all the Old Testament prophets: an unfaithful wife. But God uses even this painful infidelity for good, as Hosea's difficulties beautifully exemplify God's loving attempts to draw the spiritually promiscuous Israelites back to himself. In the New Testament, John writes three letters, all of them to different people, but a common thread running through all three is John's insistence that Christians love each other and stand for God's truth.
