This week we witness a high point in Israel's history. God personally gives Moses the laws that will set Israel apart from every other nation on earth. In the New Testament, Jesus marches unwaveringly toward Jerusalem—and his crucifixion. The disciples prepare for the Last Supper, Judas agrees to betray Jesus to his enemies, and Jesus prayerfully struggles to prepare for the suffering that he knows he will face.

Mark, as the Gospel that records the most of Jesus' miracles, lives up to its reputation in this week's readings. In Leviticus, God elaborates on his laws for holiness, giving instructions for the priesthood that will be led by Moses' older brother, Aaron. The importance of following the law is underscored by the fate of Aaron's sons, who fail to obey it.

In the Old Testament, God gives his people a list of things to avoid (such as dishonesty, sexual immorality, and idolatry) and things to pursue (such as justice, personal holiness, and compassion). In the New Testament, Mark's Gospel corroborates Matthew's account of the feeding of the four thousand, the Transfiguration, and Jesus' celebrated entry into Jerusalem. Peter makes his ringing declaration of Jesus' true identity: "You are the Messiah."
