

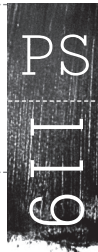
# THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

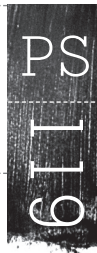
# THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

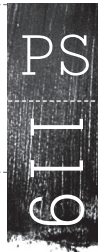
# THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

## THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

Genesis ends with Joseph's entire family settled in Egypt, but 400 years later, when the book of Exodus begins, their descendants have been forced into slavery. In the desert of Midian, God instructs a shepherd named Moses to confront the pharaoh of Egypt and lead the slaves to the Promised Land. In the New Testament, Jesus' divine nature is visibly, gloriously revealed to his disciples on the Mount of Transfiguration. Jesus also hints at his ultimate plan—he predicts his own death.

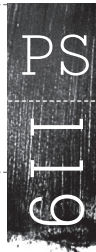
# THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

Matthew records the first Palm Sunday when Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem. In the final days before his arrest, Jesus teaches using parables, foretells the future, and fearlessly challenges the religious establishment. God demonstrates his power and righteousness in the Old Testament as well: He sends plagues down on Israel's Egyptian oppressors, leads his people through the Red Sea, and personally reveals himself to Moses at Mount Sinai.
