With the northern kingdom of Israel in ruins, the southern kingdom of Judah is all that remains of a once-flourishing nation. Righteous Judean kings like Hezekiah and Josiah strike at the roots of idolatry among their people. In the New Testament, Paul causes riots in Jerusalem after returning from his third missionary journey. Arrested by the Jewish high council, he makes a series of courtroom appearances that will lead him to the authorities of Rome.
