The Old Testament records the beginning of Israel's golden age. David's son Solomon takes the throne and becomes renowned for his God-given wisdom and wealth, which he uses to build the great Temple of the Lord. The book of Acts records another beginning, as Jesus ascends into heaven and the Holy Spirit fills the apostles at Pentecost. Led by Peter, they set out to spread the Good News to the world.
