This week in the Old Testament, we get an idea of just how numerous the Israelites have become. They worry and complain about how they will be fed in the wilderness, and although their lack of faith gets them into trouble, God still provides for them. In the New Testament, Jesus continues ministering right up to the night of his arrest. Though he struggles with the knowledge of his coming suffering, he also gives his followers a glimpse of the future, when he will return.
