

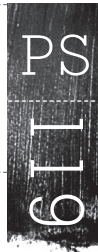
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

Ezekiel's words practically burn on the page as he berates his fellow Israelites for their reckless disobedience. 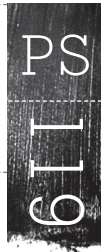
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

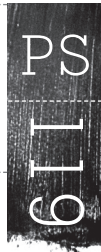
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

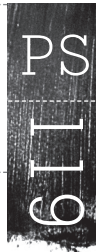
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE
