Paul opens his second letter to the Corinthians by exploring what it means to be a servant of God, encouraging his readers to have hope despite their difficulties and personal limitations. In the Old Testament, Job's struggle with his undeserved suffering culminates in God himself speaking to Job from a whirlwind. Using awe-inspiring imagery, the Lord gives Job a glimpse of his unparalleled power and grandeur.
