Using awe-inspiring imagery, the Lord gives Job a glimpse of his unparalleled power and grandeur.

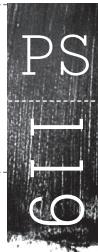
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

Together, these two books provide a lyrical perspective on wisdom, love, and the fleeting beauty of life. In the New Testament, Paul strongly asserts his authority, reminding the Corinthians of their responsibilities as Christians and as members of a church.

THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

In the Old Testament, we encounter the clearest prophecies yet of Christ's birth! The prophet Isaiah foretells the destruction of Israel at the hands of Assyria, but he also offers God's people the hope of a Redeemer yet to come. In the New Testament, Paul wraps up his letter to the Corinthians and turns to the Galatians. Forced to establish his credibility as an apostle and to root out legalism, Paul confronts his fellow believers—including Peter.

THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

In the New Testament, Paul earnestly reminds the Galatians of the most important aspect of the gospel message: Anyone and everyone can be saved through simple faith in Jesus Christ. Isaiah offers a foretaste of that joy in the Old Testament. Using words that will resonate for ages to come (and that were chosen by Handel for his famous *Messiah*), Isaiah prophesies a day when a righteous King will arrive on earth to restore and comfort his people.

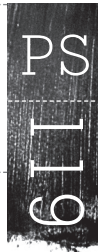
THIS WEEK IN THE BIBLE

Isaiah leaves no doubt about the accuracy of God's prophecies, predicting Israel's return from Babylonian exile 150 years before it happened. In the New Testament, Paul turns his attention to the church in the Greek city of Ephesus. Wanting to remind them of the abundance of life they have in Christ, Paul encourages them to live in the unity, freedom, and power that God promises to his followers.
